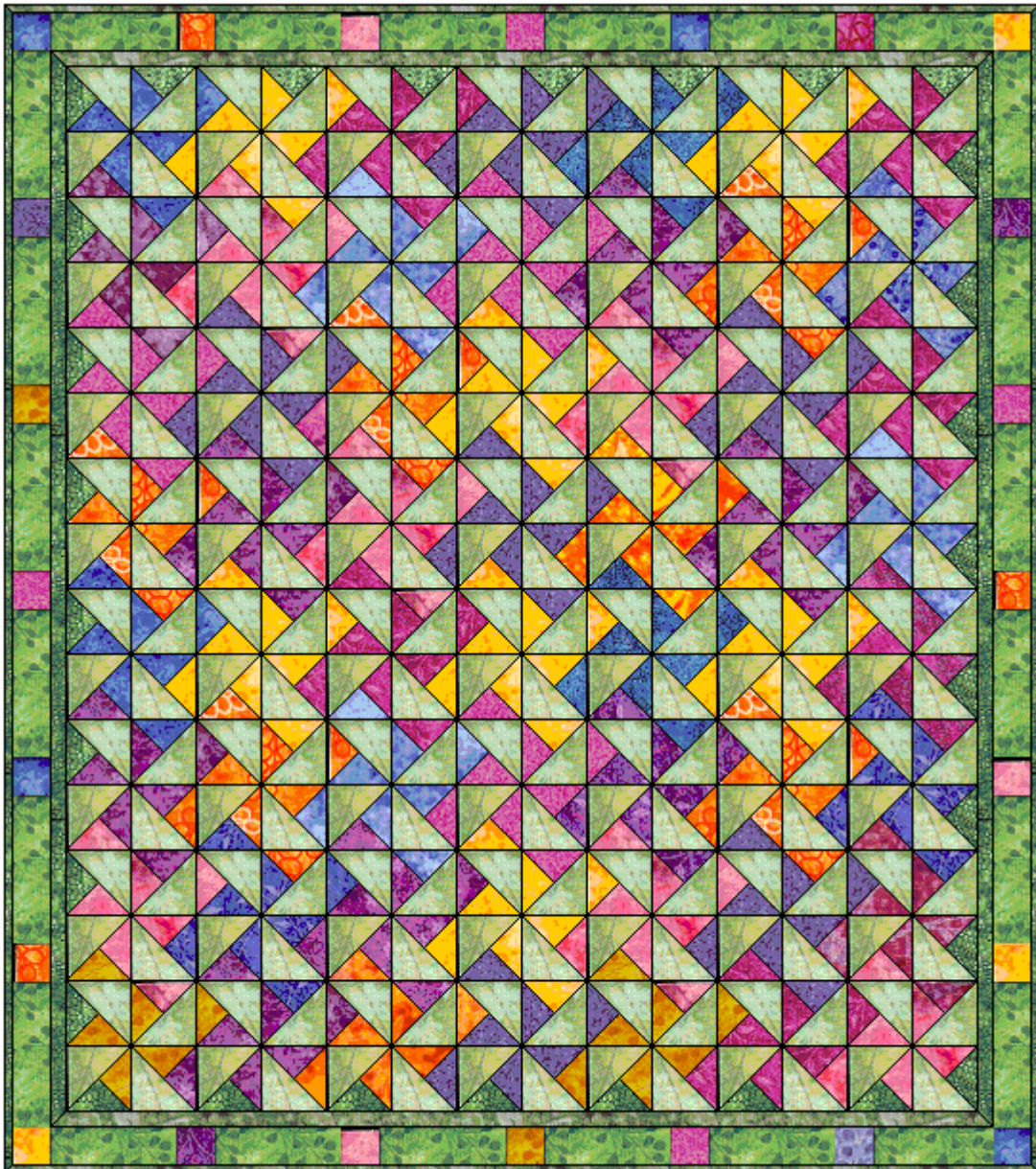

Choosing Fabrics;

Choose main colors (Orange, Pink, Purple, Blue and Yellow) and Green. To give more choices - choose varieties of tones and styles within main colors.

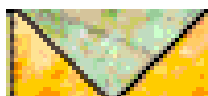

<i>Pinwheel swirls</i>	Oranges	(3) 2½" x 42 strips	2½" squares	52
	Pinks	(6) 2½" x 42	2½" squares	106
	Purples	(6) 2½" x 42	2½" squares	100
	Blues	(5) 2½" x 42	2½" squares	66
	Yellows	(5) 2½" x 42	2½" squares	64
<i>Background</i> (Greens)		(2) 4½" x 42 (3 Choices)	4½" x 2½" rect.	97 total
<i>Sides/Corners</i> (Dk. Green)		(3) 3" x 42	3" square	30
	(Med. Greens)	(2) 4" x 42 (2 choices)	4" square, 1 x Diag - 2 tri.	
	(Colors)	(1) 3" x 42	3" square	30
<i>Border #1</i> (Dk. Green)		(5) 1½" x 42		
<i>Border #2</i> (Colors)			Use remaining 2½" squares from above (5 for the top/bottom and 8 for each side)

Binding (Dk. Green) (6) 2¾" x 42

Supplies: "Creative Grid" Quarter Square Triangle Ruler

Construction;

1. Snowgeese



- Using (1) green 4½" background, place (1) 2½" color square on left side and stitch diagonally down the middle, press to corner, trim. Add (1) right 2½" color square in the same manner. Continue until all colors are constructed.

2. Blocks

- Blocks are combined with the center points face to face to create an hourglass with 2 different colors. See listing below to identify color combinations and total needed:

Pink/Purple 17

Blue/Yellow 5

Yellow/Pink 15

Blue/Pink 12

Orange/Yellow 4

Purple/Orange 12

Blue/Orange 7

Orange/Pink 3

Yellow/Purple 8

Blue/Purple 9

Purple/Purple 2

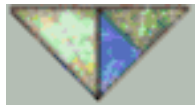

- Need 97 Total combinations. Completed blocks will turn as placed in rows (see picture).

3. Sides/Corners

Sides - Part 1:



- Combine (1) 3" color square with (1) 3" dark green square. Making sure color square is on your left - press to color and trim combined squares using the 2½" line on "Creative Grid" Quarter Square Triangle Ruler® (See Supplies). Repeat for the following colors, (all are combined with a 3" dark green square).

Orange	5	Pink	9	Purple	7
Blue	7	Yellow	2		

Sides - Part 2:

- Combine Part 1 Triangle with Med.Green Triangle cut earlier. Make sure to use an accurate 1/4" Seam Allowance and combine with color triangle unit on the left and med.Green triangle on the right, press to color triangle. Using the same ruler, the new finished triangle should be on line 3 ¼". I include completed sides in rows with blocks as pictured. Need 30 total.

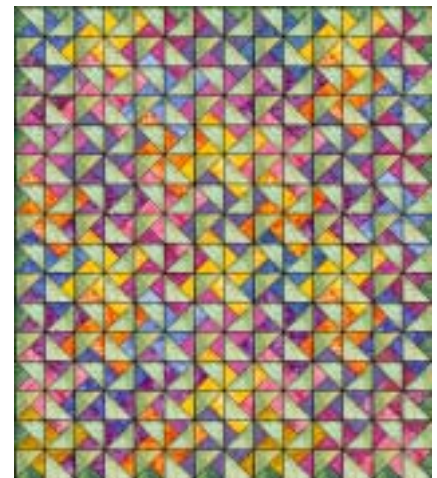
Corners

- Each corner is created using (2) Side triangles - just add the side triangle to the end of block row as pictured and the corners will develop on their own.



4. Quilt body

- Combine blocks in diagonal rows, making sure to include corners and side triangles as pictured, press as you go. Combine units 2 at a time, 4 at a time, etc. and rows together in the same manner. until you have 1 left side and 1 right side of quilt body and then combine both sides in the middle, press seams from the middle out.



5. Borders

Border #1

Combine Dark Green strips end to end, add strips to quilt body as Border #1, first to the top/bottom and then the sides.

Border #2

You will need 5 color squares for the top/bottom and 8 color squares for each side. Between the color squares are the med. Green strips. Cut med. Green strips the distance between color squares to evenly spread 5 or 8 color squares evenly, approximately 5 1/4 - 5 3/4".

6. Finishing

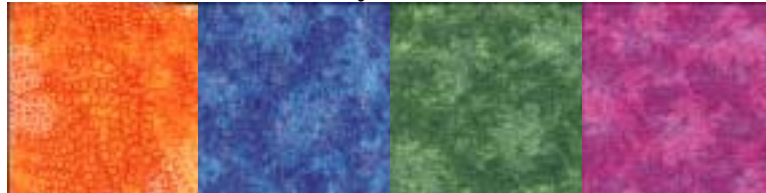
- Quilt as desired.
- Square quilt, add Binding, label and enjoy!!

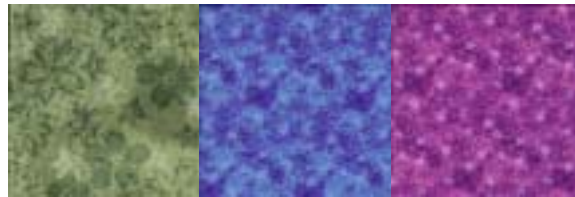
