Quilt size: 57 1/2" x 57 1/2"

Block size: 20" x 20"

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 yard **E570-66G**
- 3/4 yard each: **E569-66G, E566-66G, E566-33G**
- 1/2 yard **E571-66G**
- 3/8 yard each: **E567-66G, E572-66G, E568-389G**
- 5/8 yard **E568-8G**
- 2 5/8 yards any of the **Cloisonne Manor** collection for backing
- 61" x 61" batting

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

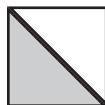
- An accurate 1/4" seam is essential to the piecing of this quilt.
- HST refers to half square triangle, a square cut once diagonally.
- FGU refers to flying geese units.

Cutting Instructions: (WOF = width of fabric)

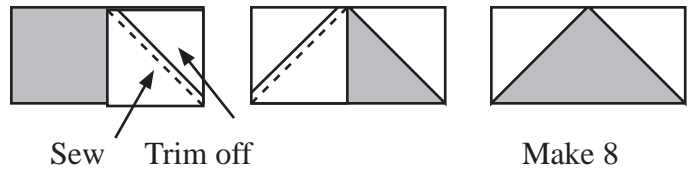
- E571-66G:** Cut (5) 5 1/2" squares
 Cut (5) 1 1/2" strips WOF for border #1
- E569-66G:** Cut (4) 10 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (8) HST.
- E566-66G:** Cut (8) 5 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (16) HST
 Cut (4) 5 1/2" squares
 Cut (6) 2" strips for binding
- E568-8G:** Cut (3) 5 1/2" strips WOF; sub-cut into (8) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles
- E566-33G:** Cut (4) 5 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (8) HST
 Cut (16) 5 1/2" squares
 Cut (5) 1 1/4" strips WOF for border #2
- E567-66G:** Cut (8) 5 1/2" squares
- E572-66G:** Cut (12) 5 1/2" squares
- E568-389G:** Cut (4) 5 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (8) HST
 Cut (4) 5 1/2" squares
- E570-66G:** Cut (6) 5" strips WOF for border #3

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

1. Make (8) HST units with the 5 7/8" **E568-389G** and **E566-33G** triangles. Press to **E568-389G**.



2. Make (8) FGU with the **E566-33G** 5 1/2" squares and **E568-8G** 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the **E566-33G** squares. Place a square right sides together on one end of the rectangle. Sew along the line. Trim seam to 1/4". Press to small triangle. Repeat on other end of rectangle.



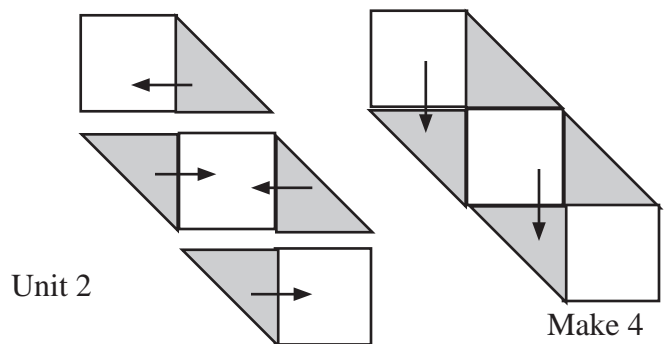
3. **Unit 1a and 1b.** Make 4 each.
 Sew a HST unit to the left of the FGU. Press to FGU.
 Sew a HST unit to the right of the FGU. Press to FGU.

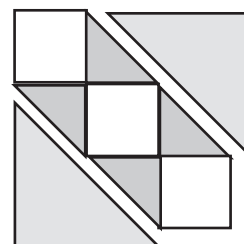
4. **Unit 2.** Make 4
 Sew 4 of the **E566-66G** 5 7/8" HST to 3 of the **E572-66G** 5 1/2" squares in the following manner. Press in the direction of the arrows.

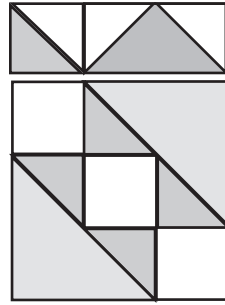
5. **Unit 3.**
 Sew a **E569-66G** 10 7/8" HST to each side of Unit 2. Press to large triangles. Repeat for all 4 Unit 2.

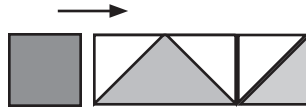
6. **Unit 4.** Sew Unit 1a to the top of Unit 3. Press to Unit 1a. Repeat for the other 3 of Unit 1a and Unit 3.

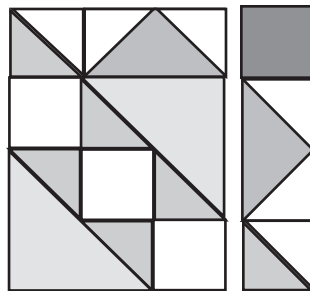
7. **Unit 5.** Sew the **E571-66G** 5 1/2" square to the left side of Unit 1b. Press to Unit 1b. Repeat with remaining Unit 1b.

8. Sew Unit 5 to the right side of Unit 4. Press to unit 5. Repeat with remaining 3 of Unit 4 and Unit 5.

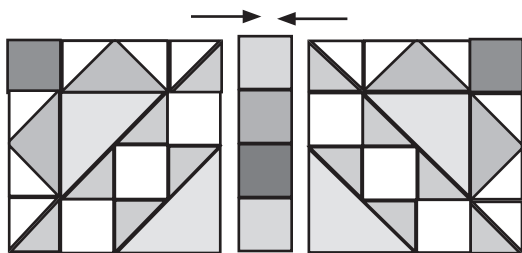

9. **Sash units.** Sew 2 **E567-66G**, 1 **E566-66G**, and 1 **E568-389G** 5 1/2" squares together as illustrated. Press in direction of the arrows. Repeat for 3 more sash units.



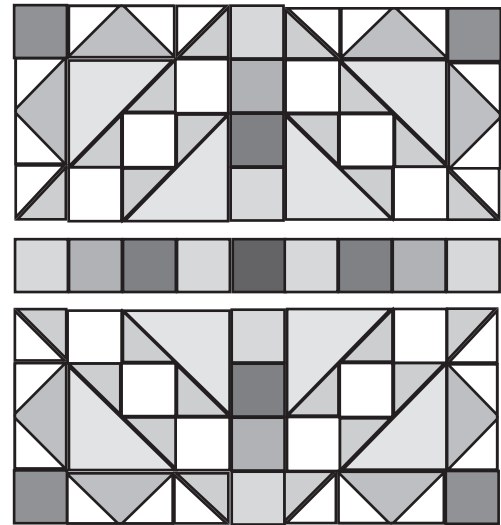
10. Sew a sash unit in between the blocks, rotating the blocks so that the **E571-66G** square is in the outer corners. Press to sash. Repeat for other 2 blocks.



11. Sew the **E571-66G** 5 1/2" square in between the remaining 2 sash units. Press to sash.



12. Sew the block sections together with the sash, rotating the sections so that the **E567-4G** square is in the outer corners. Press to sash.



BORDERS

13. Sew the (5) 1 1/2" **E571-66G** strips together with diagonal seams. Trim to (2) 45 1/2" and (2) 47 1/2" border strips (or your personal quilt measurement).

14. Sew the 45 1/2" strips to each side and the 47 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press to borders.

15. Sew the (5) 1 1/4" **E566-33G** strips together with diagonal seams. Trim to (2) 47 1/2" and (2) 49" border strips (or your personal quilt measurement).

16. Sew the 47 1/2" strips to each side and the 49" strips to the top and bottom. Press to borders.

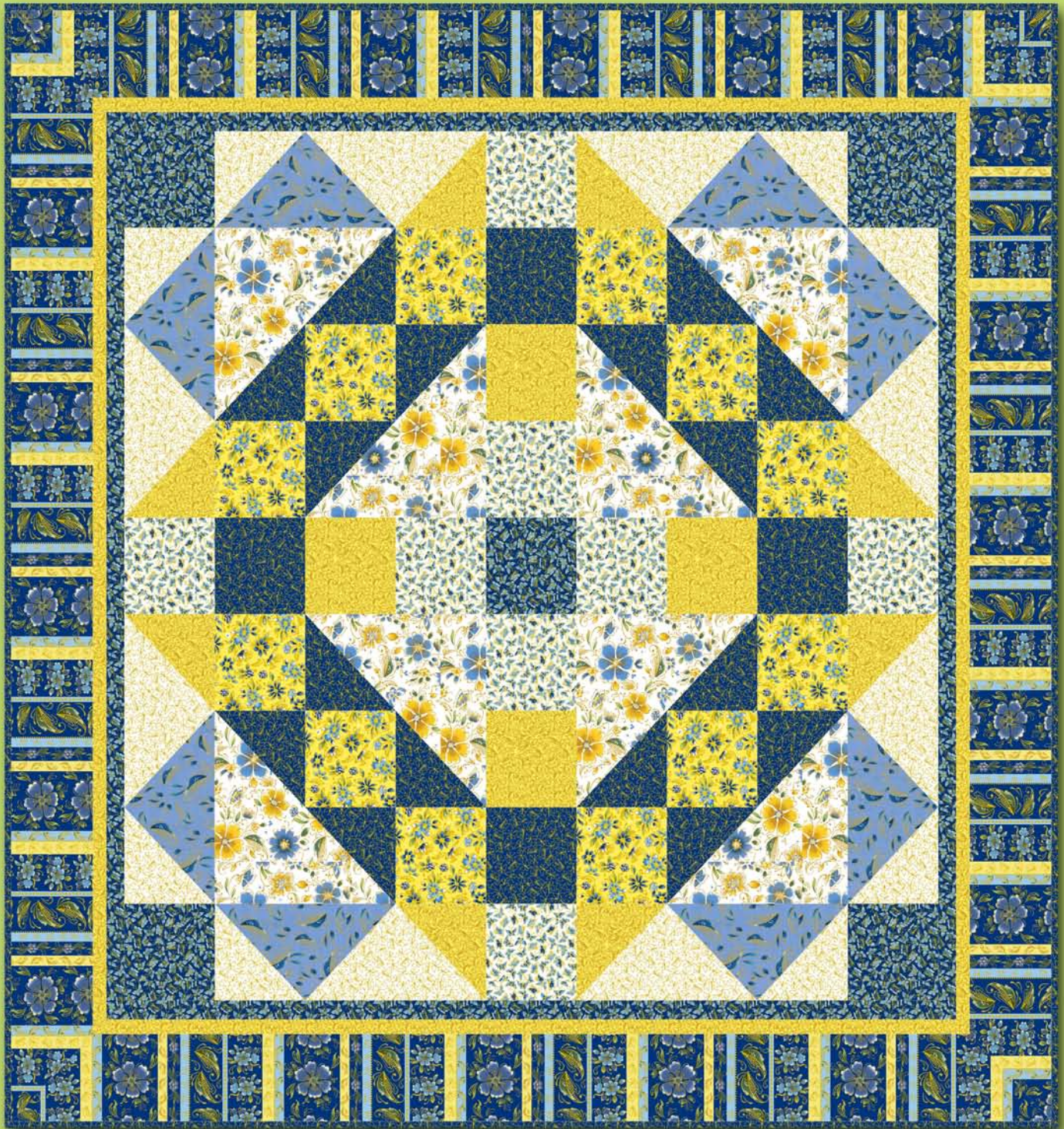
17. Sew the (6) **E570-66G** 5" strips together with **straight** seams (due to stripes). Trim to (2) 49" and (2) 58" border strips (or your personal quilt measurement).

18. Sew the 49" strips to each side and the 58" strips to the top and bottom.

Piece backing, layer top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.

Sew the (6) **E566-66G** 2" binding strip together with diagonal seams and sew to quilt using a double fold French binding technique.

Quilt size: 57 1/2" x 57 1/2"

Block size: 20" x 20"

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 yard **E570-F7G**
- 3/4 yard each: **E569-F7G, E566-19G**
- 1/2 yard **E567-19G**
- 3/8 yard each: **E567-3G, E572-F7G**
- 5/8 yard each: **E571-F7G, E566-3G, E568-9G**
- 2 5/8 yards any of the **Cloisonne Manor** collection for backing
- 61" x 61" batting

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

- An accurate 1/4" seam is essential to the piecing of this quilt.
- HST refers to half square triangle, a square cut once diagonally.
- FGU refers to flying geese units.

Cutting Instructions: (WOF = width of fabric)

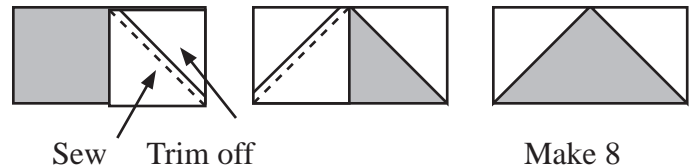
- E567-19G:** Cut (5) 5 1/2" squares
 Cut (5) 1 1/2" strips WOF for border #1
- E569-F7G:** Cut (4) 10 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (8) HST.
- E566-19G:** Cut (8) 5 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (16) HST
 Cut (4) 5 1/2" squares
 Cut (6) 2" strips for binding
- E571-F7G:** Cut (3) 5 1/2" strips WOF; sub-cut into (8) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles
- E566-3G:** Cut (4) 5 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (8) HST
 Cut (16) 5 1/2" squares
- E567-3G:** Cut (8) 5 1/2" squares
- E572-F7G:** Cut (12) 5 1/2" squares
- E568-9G:** Cut (4) 5 7/8" squares; sub-cut into (8) HST
 Cut (4) 5 1/2" squares
 Cut (5) 1 1/4" strips WOF for border #2
- E570-F7G:** Cut (6) 5" strips WOF for border #3

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

1. Make (8) HST units with the 5 7/8" **E568-9G** and **E566-3G** triangles. Press to **E568-9G**.



2. Make (8) FGU with the **E566-3G** 5 1/2" squares and **E571-F7G** 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the **E566-3G** squares. Place a square right sides together on one end of the rectangle. Sew along the line. Trim seam to 1/4". Press to small triangle. Repeat on other end of rectangle.



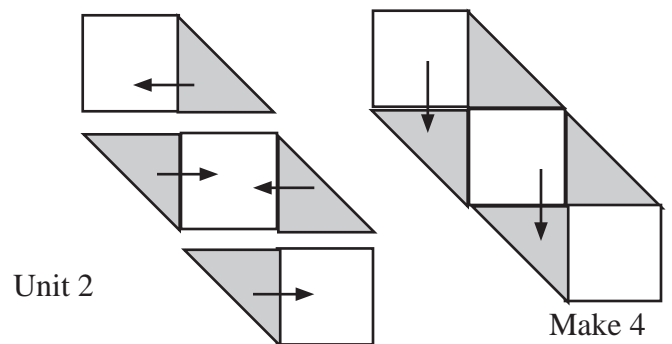
3. **Unit 1a and 1b.** Make 4 each.

Sew a HST unit to the left of the FGU. Press to FGU. Sew a HST unit to the right of the FGU. Press to FGU.



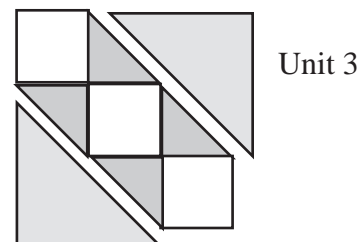
4. **Unit 2.** Make 4

Sew 4 of the **E566-19G** 5 7/8" HST to 3 of the **E572-F7G** 5 1/2" squares in the following manner. Press in the direction of the arrows.



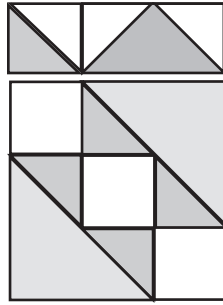
5. **Unit 3.**

Sew a **E569-F7G** 10 7/8" HST to each side of Unit 2. Press to large triangles. Repeat for all 4 Unit 2.



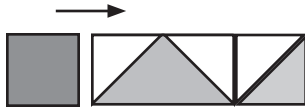
6. **Unit 4.** Sew Unit 1a to the top of Unit 3. Press to Unit 1a. Repeat for the other 3 of Unit 1a and Unit 3.

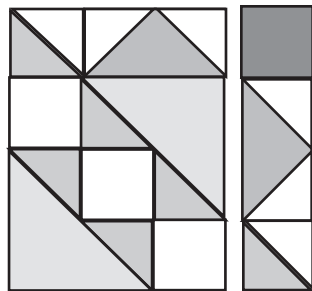
7. **Unit 5.** Sew the **E567-19G** 5 1/2" square to the left side of Unit 1b. Press to Unit 1b. Repeat with remaining Unit 1b.

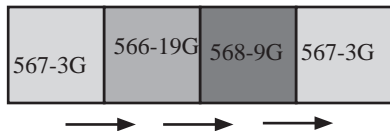


8. Sew Unit 5 to the right side of Unit 4. Press to unit 5. Repeat with remaining 3 of Unit 4 and Unit 5.

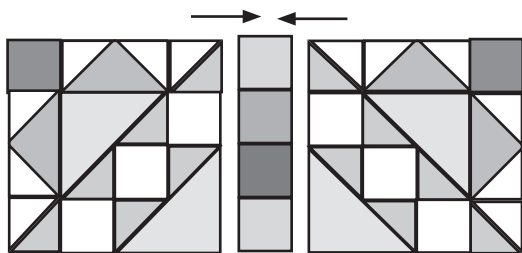
Completed block



9. **Sash units.** Sew 2 **E567-3G**, 1 **E566-19G**, and 1 **E568-9G** 5 1/2" squares together as illustrated. Press in direction of the arrows. Repeat for 3 more sash units.



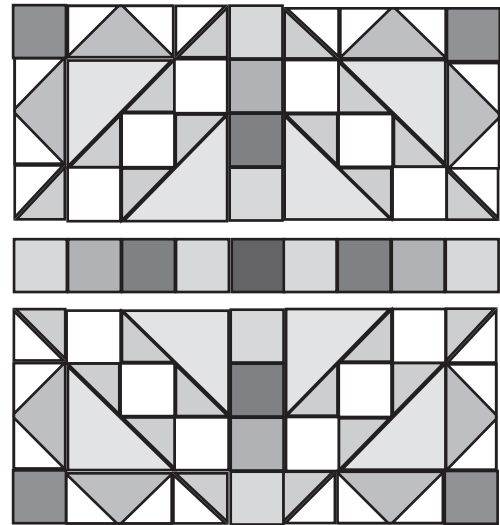
10. Sew a sash unit in between the blocks, rotating the blocks so that the **E567-19G** square is in the outer corners. Press to sash. Repeat for other 2 blocks.



11. Sew the **E567-19G** 5 1/2" square in between the remaining 2 sash units. Press to sash.



12. Sew the block sections together with the sash, rotating the sections so that the **E567-19G** square is in the outer corners. Press to sash.



BORDERS

13. Sew the (5) 1 1/2" **E567-19G** strips together with diagonal seams. Trim to (2) 45 1/2" and (2) 47 1/2" border strips (or your personal quilt measurement).

14. Sew the 45 1/2" strips to each side and the 47 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press to borders.

15. Sew the (5) 1 1/4" **E568-9G** strips together with diagonal seams. Trim to (2) 47 1/2" and (2) 49" border strips (or your personal quilt measurement).

16. Sew the 47 1/2" strips to each side and the 49" strips to the top and bottom. Press to borders.

17. Sew the (6) **E570-F7G** 5" strips together with **straight** seams (due to stripes). Trim to (2) 49" and (2) 58" border strips (or your personal quilt measurement).

18. Sew the 49" strips to each side and the 58" strips to the top and bottom.

Piece backing, layer top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.

Sew the (6) **E566-19G** 2" binding strip together with diagonal seams and sew to quilt using a double fold French binding technique.
